



INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

All authors are invited to register their works according to the themes of the Congress. It is possible to apply with research and non-research works, as well as e-poster presentations (electronic poster) Final assessment whether the work will be presented orally or with an e-poster will be given by the Scientific Committee of the Congress. Abstract should be written in English or in the author's mother tongue, in font Ariel, font size 12 pts. The abstract should not exceed 300 words. The abstract should emphasize the following headings (Ariel, 12 pts, bold, alignment left)

For research paper

If the authors want to register with a research paper, then the paper must include the following parts:

INTRODUCTION - the main problem and goal of the research must be stated.

MATERIAL AND METHODS - the main characteristics of the implementation of the research should be described - the model and the manner of selection of the examinees, evaluation procedures, methods and duration of the intervention.

RESULTS - the main results of the survey should be described and other important measurements should be mentioned.

CONCLUSION - the conclusions drawn from the research and the clinical relevance of the study should be provided. Positive and negative findings should be given equally.

LITERATURE - citation: Vancouver / Harvard style.

For non-research paper

If the authors want to register with a non-research paper that does not contain research work, then the paper must include the following parts:

INTRODUCTION - the main problem and goal of the research must be stated.

CONTENT- the content is a thematic summary, from which the reader gets a preliminary insight into the subject.

CONCLUSION - to state the conclusion corresponding to the given issue.

LITERATURE - citation: Vancouver / Harvard style.

The abstracts should be submitted by August 25th, 2023 the latest, to the following email address: **kongresskopje2023@gmail.com**. Upon acceptance of the work by the Scientific Committee, the Committee will send the author a confirmation of receipt and approval of the work, mode of presentation, the language on which the paper will be presented and an invitation to submit the complete paper, not longer than 10 pages A4, font Ariel, 12 pts, line spacing 1.5. The papers will be on CD.

Authors are fully responsible for the content published in the paper. Also, the authors of the submitted works should submit the text to the Scientific Committee without previous publishing of the same content in any other congress, professional meeting, domestic or foreign magazine. If the text is previously published, the authors should indicate the same.

The text of the work belongs exclusively to the authors. The references are cited Vancouver style. The names of the authors should be written under the title, centered, with full name and surname, title and place of work of the author.

If the members of the Scientific Committee establish that further work and explanations are needed relating to the work, all such comments will be sent to the first author only. All works should be in the form of PowerPoint presentations with a duration of 15 minutes.



Electronic poster / e-poster

The electronic poster, or e-poster, is a poster similar to the traditional paper poster, presented on a white screen with a projector. It is a new concept of static electronic image form. The e-poster is presented through a previously created poster in an imaging software (CorelDraw or Photoshop). The e-poster can be presented through a USB drive, DVD/CD, in the form of a high resolution image, JPG or PDF, font 12, and a file size up to 50MB. When making the poster with the software, the resolution should be max. 1780 x 1000 pixels. The high resolution of the e-poster allows for an easier way of communication with the audience. The organizer provides the e-poster presentation equipment: laptop with OS: Windows 10, projector with a 1280x800 resolution.
